“My goal as an artist is to walk my own path and create special moments. Moments that show all of us how liberating it feels to express our own vision.”
“If I enjoyed a straightforward nine-to-five routine, I’d be sitting in some government office today. But I don’t. I’m here to move people, to provoke them – and, frankly, to entertain.”

Malik Adams is not a musician who simply releases songs. He is the architect of his own universe. His debut “Breakin’ the F*** Out” is more than a track – it’s a statement: a break with convention, a call to push boundaries and to fully step into one’s own identity. Two additional tracks are already lined up, provocative, profound and driven by vision. With every note and every line, Adams shapes his world and demonstrates his unwavering belief in change and creative freedom.

He discovered music at a young age, learned instruments, yet initially followed more conventional routes: hosting live shows, working in radio, modeling. All of it became part of a bigger picture – the desire to inspire people, to excite them, and to create something new through bold, imaginative ideas.

Based in Berlin, Adams is a true world citizen. Since childhood, he has been closely connected to the United States, and India has also played a defining role in his life. These global influences flow directly into his music, shaping his creative perspective and energy.

In 2018, he met star producer Eric Sanicola (Jennifer Lopez, One Direction). The connection was immediate, fueled by Adams’ relentless passion and work ethic. For “Breakin’ the F*** Out,” he also worked with top professionals: GRAMMY winner Trevor Muzzy, hit songwriter Jimmy Burney and acclaimed choreographer Jimmie Surles. Yet Malik Adams remains fully in control: music, visuals, career – everything carries his artistic signature. The concepts for his videos originate in his own mind; each story is unique, sometimes minimalist, sometimes provocative.

His music refuses boundaries – blending pop, EDM and everything in between. It is a soundtrack for those who dream, dare and live. Malik Adams stands not only for music, but for courage, authenticity and the power to forge one’s own path.
